Safety Management:

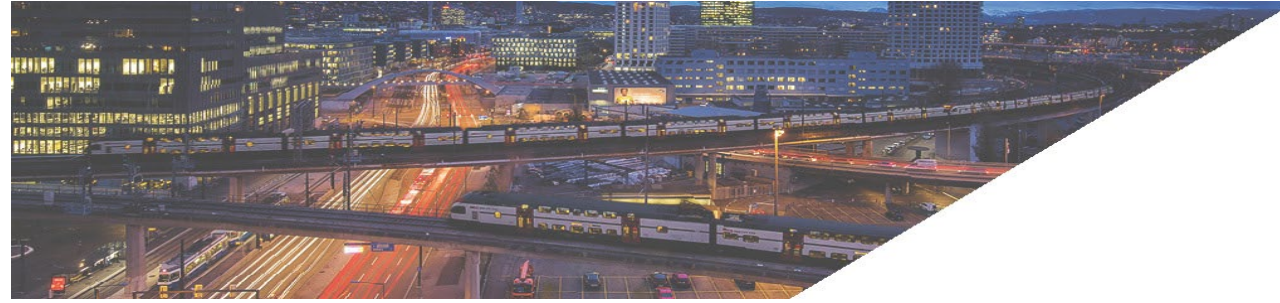
Implement the health, safety, and sustainability programs of the Colas Rail Group and Kummler+Matter to promote a safe working environment for all employees.
